The 39 Bach Flower Essences

Agrimony, Agrimonia Eupatoria	This Remedy for animals: That are oversensitive or show unusual behaviour evoked by stress.
Aspen, Populus tremula	This Remedy for animals: That suffer from fear of unknown origin. For animals being very sensitive up to being anxious and apprehensive.
Beech, Fagus sylvatica	This Remedy for animals: For intolerant, inflexible or easily irritated animals. The beech remedy can help with intolerance of other animals and changes of routine.
Centaury, Centaurium umbellatum	This Remedy for animals: That are overly submissive, are bullied by other animals or grovel. For animals that urinate from submissive behavior
Cerato, Ceratostigma willmottiana	This Remedy for animals: For inattentive, distracted, helpless and uncertain animals. Helpful for training sessions. The cerato remedy can help, working or show animals, if they lose confidence or cannot work independently.

Cherry Plum, Prunus cerasifera	This Remedy for animals: For animals that lose control and become aggressive, bite and are dangerous. If they have violent impulses towards other animals and people.
Chestnut Bud, Aesculus hippocastanum	This Remedy for animals: That tend to make the same mistakes over and over. Failure to learn. Lack of concentration.
Chicory, Cichorium intybus	This Remedy for animals: That seek for attention, feel displeasure when attention is turned elsewhere or have some separation problems.
Clematis, Clematis vitalba	This Remedy for animals: That are dreaming, disinterested, inattentive and are indifferent to the world around them. The clematis remedy can revitalise and restore alertness.
Crab Apple, Malus Pumila	This Remedy for animals: Good for any situation where cleansing or getting rid of toxins is required.
Elm, Ulmus procera	This Remedy for animals: That are overwhelmed with their situation. Elm remedy can help to cope with new situations (e.g. travelling, stress).
Gentian, Gentiana amarella	This Remedy for animals: That give up easily or are easily discouraged. Helpful in training programs.
Gorse, Ulex europaeus	This Remedy for animals: That tend to depression, resignation, apathy and a pervading sense of hopelessness. Loss of the will to survive and go on.

Holly, <i>Ilex aquifolium</i>	This Remedy for animals: That feel anger, hate or aggression. Good for animals that have been mistreated.
Honeysuckle, <i>Lonicera Caprifolium</i>	This Remedy for animals: That are at a loss after losing a friend, companion or their owner. That lose their appetite.
Hornbeam, <i>Carpinus betulus</i>	This Remedy for animals: That can't adjust to changes in routine. Hornbeam remedy can renew enthusiasm and energy after periods of inactivity.
Impatiens, <i>Impatiens glandulifera</i>	This Remedy for animals: That are hyperactive, impatient and always fast moving. For animals that never seem to slow down, that are snappy or nervous. For dogs pulling on the leash.
Larch, <i>Larix decidua</i>	This Remedy for animals: That are insecure, uncertain, poor or have reduced self-confidence. It can help show animals that suffer from nerves in the ring.
Mimulus, <i>Mimulus guttatus</i>	This Remedy for animals: That have a lack of security. For animals with general fears and nervous anticipation of situations or people and for hypersensitive ones.

Rock Rose, Helianthemum nummularium	This Remedy for animals: That have panic or great fear and can't calm down. Helpful for animals with lack of courage.

Sweet Chestnut, <i>Castanea sativa</i>	<p>This Remedy for animals: That have reached the limit of their physical or mental endurance. The sweet chestnut remedy can help with exhaustion.</p>
Vervain, <i>Verbena officinalis</i>	<p>This Remedy for animals: That are overbearing and over enthusiastic. This remedy helps, if the animal wears people out by their excess energy. It calms hyperactive and restless animals.</p>
